Sophyto Review



I was very pleased to sample the new line Sophyto which launched this year here in the UK. According to Sophyto, it is the purest most endorsed collection of certified organic natural skincare in the world, and is geared toward professional marketing sources like dermatologists, spas, plastic surgeons, etc. Nevertheless, you can also find the products online at SophytoOrganics.com in the US and SophytoOrganics.co.uk in Britain.

I have been using the **Ultra Mild Silken Cleanser** (£19 125ml) which contains Aloe Vera juice and cucumber juice and really does go on and wash off silkily. It has a refreshing clean scent, to my mind its like fresh rain, owing to the cucumber and aloe vera together. This cleanser is beneficial for inflamed, or sensitive skin following; laser resurfacing, micro-dermabrasion, chemical peels, chemotherapy, radiation and sun burn.

The other Sophyto product I've been enjoying is the **Purifying Active Face Mask** (£19 50 ml x 5 individual packets). This is a very refreshing mask that is formulated with marine-rich peptides, amino acids, proteins and vitamins to cleanse impurities from the epidermis. *"Derived from green single-cell*

freshwater micro-algae, this feather light gel will help to neutralise the damaging effects of environmental and lifestyle pollutants, to give skin a fresher appearance. Sterile, single dose sachets offer a system that encapsulates bio-active ingredients making it convenient for travel and dosage. "



This mask had the desired effect, as the first time I used it I had not slept well the night before and felt my skin looked dry and slightly grey. The mask did seem to brighten and tighten up my skin while leaving it silky soft. I personally love anything with marine/algae ingredients (I'm a real Spirulina user!) so this appealed greatly. My only complaint, which is why I have have given it four out of five lotus flowers, is the over-packaging. I understand the idea of individual dosage and travel convenience, but one packet seemed almost too much for one use, and when my husband first saw the box, his first comment was about the excessive packaging.
